Determine if the home has a furnace or boiler. Then you can tell what kind of maintenance will be required, check for a warranty, and understand the efficiency and longevity of the system.	☐ Water heater update date:// If you're looking at a home that's older, you'll quickly notice if there are issues with your water taking a while to heat up.
Determine age of HVAC unit date:/ If your new home's HVAC unit is too old, it may not run as efficiently as you'd like, which means it could be more expensive to operate in the long-run.	 ☐ Locate shut off valves date:// Most main water shut-off valves can be found in the utility room, closet, or basement. ☐ Test all faucets/flush all toilets date://
☐ Who installed the unit? date:/ Check who installed the home's unit in order to contact that provider if any questions about the system arise.	Check for things like water pressure and if the tank refills properly on the toilet. Check for water damage date://
☐ Is system still under warranty? date:/ / To find out if your system is still under a warranty, you may have to contact the company who installed the unit.	If there are signs of water damage, make sure the problem has been fixed. Clean/replace AC air filter date://
☐ Heat pumps & efficiency Just like any other piece of HVAC equipment, heat pumps require maintenance, and you should see if factors such as size and efficiency work for you.	Determine your new home's furnace filter size.
